

# **Warranty Guidelines**

Please read before using the rev•o•lu•tion<sup>™</sup> case carts. Periodically clean cart as follows to preserve its luster and prolong its life.



#### Stainless steel

• Stainless steel cleaner may be used on stainless portions of the cart only. Rinse with clean water and dry with chamois to prevent corrosion and water spotting.

▲ <u>CAUTION</u> ▲ To avoid scratching <u>DO NOT</u> <u>USE</u> stainless steel cleaner on powder coated white doors or polycarbonate windows.

Cart Body

(Including windows & bumpers)

 Wipe down with a mild soap (Joy dish soap recommended) and lukewarm water solution using a soft lint free cloth. Rinse with clean water and dry with chamois to prevent corrosion and water spotting.

#### White Bumper

 Scuffs and marks can be removed using Isopropyl Alcohol (rubbing) and a soft lintfree cloth.



### Wheels

Lubrication is not possible on these maintenance-free  $re\text{-volve}^{TM}$  casters. Check wheels for visible points of tread wear. Check for any loose caster mounting bolts. Tighten to 100 to 105 in-lb.

#### Windows

- Made of scratch resistant, highimpact polycarbonate.
- Wipe down with a mild soap (Joy dish soap recommended) and lukewarm water solution using a soft lint free cloth. Rinse with clean water & dry with chamois to prevent water spotting. Formula 409 or Isopropyl (rubbing) Alcohol may also be used.

#### ▲ <u>CAUTION</u> ▲ To avoid scratching windows <u>DO NOT USE</u>:

- Glass cleaner (Windex, etc.)
- Any cleaner with abrasives
- Abrasive cloths, squeegees or other cleaning implements on polycarbonate windows.

#### **Replacement Parts**

Casters, handles, doors, door latches & catches, windows, bumpers, can be removed and replaced if needed.
