CLEANING & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Cleaning & Care:

We all know that in a medical environment, it is easy for surfaces to become dirty and soiled from blood, bodily fluids, betadine, barium, and other fluids.

Do:

- Clean with cold water and a mild detergent immediately after contact with fluids.
 Household 409 Spray can be used to clean and remove dust and dirt from your coated sponge.
- To disinfect your sponges, we recommend the use of disinfectant wipes. Allow a drying time of at least 3 minutes.
- Store your sponges in a clean and dry area when not in use.

Don't:

- Do not use Bleach or any harsh chemicals on your coated sponge.
- Do not autoclave or launder.
- Do not soak/submerse sponges in water.
